Holocausto said the album has only previously released tracks with bad sounds, and it's not worth buying. Besides, no one should support the kind of profitmaking Turbo Music is now doing! This label rips off both the band and its fans! Do not support Turbo Music!!

CARTILAGE demo In Godly Flesh should have been released by Rotting Funeral Records, but as the label doesn't exist anymore (as doesn't the Blazing Corpse 'zine by the same people), it won't see the light of the day. But some foreign labels have been interested in releasing a couple of (hopefully new!) CARTILAGE tracks as a 7"ep, one possibility would be Corpse Grinder Records, but that's not sure yet.

The Finnish death metal legends FUNEBRE have split up after the release of their debut lp Children Of The Scorn (Spinefarm Rec.). Some of the members have put up a band in meaning to play some sort of heavy metal.

out their debut 1p through Relapse Records.


The Spanish Drowned Productions should let out the debut lp of another Finnish band, PURTENANCE.



You should have heard thel demo entitled Taog Eht Fo Htao Eht. by these Finnish black metal dudes, IMPALED NAZARENE. In my opinion this tape is to be consi-dered as one of the most interesting demo releases of this year with its five brilliant tracks and added and dark intro, outro and inner intros (?) The sound is excellent, it creates a great atmosphere of the flaming purgatory of damnation and ... I don't see any clear negative points in this demo. You can get it (means you MUST get it!) You can get by sending 20mk (Finland) \$5 (world) to IMPALED 

In the beginning of this interview I scouted if Mika had something to add..

Mika: "No, but thanks for the interview and have success with your corpse-zine. Ave Abaddon!"

You're welcome! Although I don't know about any corpsezines, I tend to have success. But what about the success your demo has got? How much have you printed and sold it so far (September)?

Mika: "So far we have printed 200 copies and I just ordered 200 more. So far it has sold 174 copies and all of them in Finland

(well, some has been given as promo copies). I believe we can sell around 500 copies easily."

What about the demo in general? Are you happy with the way it turned out, and how was going your recording session?

Mika: "Taog Eht Fo Htao Eht was recorded in two days at Tico Tico studio which is probably best studio for band like we are. It contains five five so called songs. intros / inner intros and outro. What can I tell you (Tell me anything you'd -Niko)? like to ... There was no problems to record songs because we have been playing so long time together. I am pleased with the way it turned out, it doesn't sound Finnish band for sure!"

Then tell something

about each track.

Mika: "Well, let's clear this out. There are songs (yepp, five VOU -Niko); already metioned! Condemned To Hell, The Crucified, Morbid Fate, In The Name Of Satan and Damnation (Raping The Angels). Three first one are taken from Shemhamforash reh.tape but we recorded them because Shemhamforash wasn't success at all and I like these tracks and moreover, they haven't never

been available as studio versions. Condemned To Hell is, what the fuck I am supposed to say, song. Cruficied and Morbid Fate are both old MUTILATIONtracks. Morbid Fate is written in '88 and The Crucified is from '89. In The Name Of Satan is the newest track and short one, lasts about 45 seconds (The Orucified isn't very long either. -Niko). Damnation written in March was and in my opinion it is our best track.

#### THE OATH OF THE GOAT

You got a deal for a 7"ep. Please tell something more about it.

Mika: "Our ep, titled Goat Perversion, will have three tracks, one Goat Perversion (very clever) and on the -side In The Name Of Satan and Damnation (Raping The Angels). This ep should be out early november '91. will be released by Nosferatu records (Italy) and Nosferatu will also print two-sided t-shirts. Don't ask me prices or hecause don't know. T-shirts should be out at the same time as the ep can't tell you anything about the cover etc. but they aren't gonna be ultramorbid brutal stuff like everybody nowadays claims, just satanic. Wait and see...

I also heard a rumour about making a contract with Nuclear Blast, but as I thought, it's everything but true, as far as Mika says: "I don't know anything about it.

Well, what does your gig situation look like? What songs do you play on stage, any covers?

Mika: "Only three gigs so far and not a single in sight but this is quite understandable because I don't kiss asses to get gigs like most bands seem to do. If somebody wants to have us for gig, that's no problem, just pay gas and we will come. Khrrmzxglmphx, back to this tape. The basic sound is good, but the guitars could have mixed louder to my opinion. And Pasi's and Tormi's vocals seem to be too loud sometimes. But you'll get used to it for sure.

Here are four tracks, Yellow Phlegm (Are the lyrics written under the flu??), Perdition, Enigma Of Departed and The First Symptoms Of Rotting. I prefer Perdition and The First Symptoms Of Rotting (however this one doesn't have very clever title...).

day was a good one. though didn't get too much mail. Actually the only letter I received was from Osmose Productions. It was a strange letter indeed, including a MASACRE biocraphy including a tape, and a flyer advertising the lp Requiem by these Colombian death metal gods MASACRE. Nothing more.

So I have no idea what is this tape, but I guess it is some kind of advance their album, tape to including three tracks of which I don't know any titles or anything. haven't got very familiar with the music of MASACRE previously. No, wait a minute! The last track is Sepulcros En Ruinos, that's the one I've heard somewhere before. But without having any further know-ledge, I can say they play really brutal, and good death metal. Excellent death metal. Excellent sounds!

Because I can't give you much information about the music, I still have the bio and can talk some crap about the band's history.

Briefly; MASACRE was formed in 1988. In July'89 they recorded their first demo named Colombia... Imperio Del Terror. After some line-up changes MASACRE returned to the studio to work on a new demo in November'90. The demo was named Cancer De Nuestros Dias. Again some line-up changes...and the current line-up contains of

TIAMAT should need no in-

TIAMAT should need no introduction. Since their times under the name TREBLINKA, they've released their debut album Sumerian Cry and a 7"ep A Winter Shadow. But time has gone, and these aren't the most fresh vinyls anymore... So, the question is evoken; what's going on with the band by now? And how's life today, Hellslaughter?

Hellslaughter: "Very good! We've just recorded the tracks for our second album pre-titled Astral Sleep, which will come out soon through Century Media Records."

So, you've left C.M.F.T. Records. What were the reasons in particular to the label change? And do you like XYSTER (they were also on C.M.F.T., weren't they?)?

Hellslaughter: "Yeah, we have left C.M.F.T. and we have now signed a much better contract with Century Media Rec. I liked XYSTER's demo Black Bible but not more!"

#### THE KINGLY DEAD

Your line-up changed back then after Sumerian Cry. Did the name change from TREBLINKA to TIAMAT have any effect on it? And do you think that your music has changed to some noticable direction after this line-up change?

Hellslaughter: "The name change and the line-up change are two different things. Basically it's the same band. Of course we sound a bit different now but it is the same kind of riffing, just a natural progression."

After all still think you've slowed down abit, if A Winter Shadow is compared to Sumerian Cry...
BATHORY-influence, perhaps?

Hellslaughter: 'Our two latest songs are grindy so don't be too sure! We're not trying to play fast, nor slow. We are not trying to be the heaviest band, nor the most brutal. We are playing music which we like, whatever people will call it. We want the music to create a mood... It could be a brutal, spiritual or a depressive mood but it is important that the music is created by feelings and not 'trends'." Yepp, let's then talk

Yepp, let's then talk about trends. For example in Sweden there's an enormous scene, as everybody knows. But sometimes I think there are too many bands which tend not to be so original, they just try



to be similar to the legend NIHILIST / ENTOMBED... "You

Hellslaughter: "You are right! We have got too many trend bands here in Sweden that really sucks. Of course we still have original bands that kills... UNLEASHED, GROTESQUE / AT THE GATES, ABSURD, CROWLEY, DESECRATOR, MERCILESS and some more."

What do you think is the best black metal band by now?

Hellslaughter: "By now? Does it exist a black metal band today?? The latest black metal gods were GROTESQUE but they split up recently. Maybe you could call MORBID ANGEL a black metal band? They rule!"

Hnm...! don't think MORBID ANGEL rule anymore, at least their latest album, in my opinion it's fulfilled with overtechnical crap!

#### MALICIOUS MOODS

Have you said goodbye to your make-ups, or why didn't you have them on A Winter Shadow picture?

Hellslaughter: "Maybe we'll use it...maybe not! That depends on which mood we're in. I always have my nail bracelet with me on gigs but I only use it sometimes...when I really feel for it. The latest time we have really felt for not wearing too much of the spikes, corpsepaint...

One thing that will always be there is inverted crosses, pentagrams etc. because that is NOT a cool thing...IT IS A LIFESTYLE!"

What about your stage performance, then? Do you have much effects in your show? (It's a shame I didn't get to Helsinki wher you played there instead of ENTOMBED...well, I heard about it just a day before the gig!)

Hellslaughter: "We are not playing too often but we will hopefully tour in the near future. Yeah, we'll have stage-show!! Definitely!"

Then it's quite radical change of the subject. Say your opinion about EU-ROPE and YNGWIE MALMSTEEN!

Hellslaughter: "They did some good stuff five years ago... Today I don't like it!"

#### ASTRAL END

I, as everbody else, would be interested in your plans for the future...!

Hellslaughter: "I Won't tell you too much... We'll have to wait and see!"

There are many mayhemic bands in the underground nowadays, but the only true that is extremely deep in the underground are the true MAYHEM from Norway. As many know, the guitarist Euronymous is also running an underground label called Deathlike Silence Records.

But the most shocking happening around the band during this year must be that their vocalist Dead killed himself. The question is awaken; why did he do it? Was it shown in his lyrics or perhaps in some other way (I heard he had been thinking of it for 17 years...!)?

Euronyous: "Dead had always been a very dark-minded, depressive person who used to spend much time alone in the woods, and he believed that he was of So you can another world. say that he just longed to get away. The only thing which kept him from doing this many years before, was the true old black metal lifestyle, but in these the "scene" when days consists of only totally normal people in jogging suits, children with skate-boards and "death" metal bands with society lyrics that's not (Yes! -Niko), at all... clever he felt that the only thing he cared for was dead, and decided to die. We all worship the ancient black metal bands with black clothes, spikes and crosses and we have declared WAR against the trend idiots! You could see some of Dead's thoughts in his lyrics, he wrote a lot of his dreams about Transylvania, dark legends, and ancient castles and so on. In his last lyrics - "Life Eternal" he's very clearly writing about himself. He wrote it a couple hours before he died!"

#### THE MOON IS FREEZING ...

This is certainly boring and stupid for almost everybody, but there might be some people who don't know much about the band's history. So, would you please tell some basic facts about the MAYHEMic history?

Euronymous: "We started up in '84, the line-up was then me, Necro Butcher and Manheim on drums. First gig in '85 with a session vocalist called Messiah, first demo Pure Fucking Armageddon in '86 and in we did the Deathcrush demo/mini lp with Maniac on vocals. Maniac and Manheim left after this and we got Dead and Hellhammer. We recorded 2 trax in studio for a Swedish compilation lp in spring '90, and in the autumn we toured in East-Germany and Turkey. That brings us up to the current events."

Okay. But why have you been so quiet all the time? And it seems MAYHEM aren't too productive, only these two demos and 2 compilation tracks in 8 years! How come? Or perhaps you have done other songs but not released them...? If you have any other tracks, please tell something about them.

Euronymous: "We refuse to make standard music like most other bands do, and each new MAYHEM song must be better than everything in our ears. This has made a lot of problems before because we have disagreed quite a lot about the musical direction, Necro Butcher wanted us to play like we did on the Pure Fucking Armageddon demo, Dead wanted some diffuse middle age inspired stuff which he never managed to

I and Hellhammer have had the same ideas and now we can work freely on them. Still we'll use very much time to make songs in order to make each song samething special. And then we have the economic aspect - We've not had any money to be able to record anything before."

So is it propably because of the lack of money that you haven't got a new press of your Deathcrush mini-lp? I'm sure it would still sell quite well...

Euronymous: "We have plans to do it, but we'll probably wait until after the lp. There are a lot of demands for it so it's about time. I hate limited editions."

Tell something about a mayhemic song creation. What does inspire you? Who makes the music?

Euronymous: "I make the music and I'm inspired by moods. If I get inspiration, I try to turn off all lights and make dark, gruesome atmosphere and then channel this into the music. It often takes quite long time between each time I get real inspiration, and this is perhaps also one of the reasons for why we don't have so many songs."

#### ... THE TALES TURN MORBID ...

Back there in '87 (Deathcrush...) you had a kind of those splatter/gore-typed lyrics such as Chainsaw Gutsfuck. Do you think there's any MAYHEM influences nowadays, as almost every band is using the same kind of stuff in their lyrics (which to cut it out I see quite boring)? Mainly the influences come from CARCASS, I guess, but

Euronymous: "I don't think so, most of the trend people today (90% of the people who listen to this music) "discovered" death metal through MORBID ANGEL one year ago or so, and hence they have never heard about us. Hell, many of the idiot have not even

heard about VENOM!!"

VENOM (except their two first albums rule!), but what about CELTIC FROST? Many years ago you played CELTIC covers. What do you think of the band today? I mean the albums Cold Lake (which is pure crap!) and Vanity/Nemesis (which I can listen to...).


the two last albums of CELTIC FROST, it's so unbelievably worthless. But why should we listen to them when we can listen to masterpieces like Morbid Tales?"



Euronymous: "The current rate is about 2 times a year (Really? -Niko)... After the tour we haven't been able to practise much because of a lot of problems, equipment fucking up etc etc. Before we played 2-3 times a week. Right now we're even too broke to rent a rehearsal place. Things are hard these days..."

Yes, they seem to be. So you don't do many gigs today, because of the rehearsal problems, or what? And when you play live, do you play any

Euronymous: "We refuse to play to play live now, especially in Norway. The reason is that the only people who go to concerts are children in jogging suits, caps and skateboards and our music is not for them. We want our audience look like old HELLHAMMER, BATHORY, DESTRUCTION, SAR-COFAGO etc., and to be Spikes rule! It's possible that we'll accept an offer to tour through Hungary, Romania, Bulgaria, Turkey and Israel though, but this won't be for while yet anyway. As for cover songs, before the tour we used to rehearse on Satan's Curse with POS-SESSED and it's possible

You sa to said that you refuse especially in Norway. So in your eyes the Norwegian underground scene doesn't too good, is it so? look Could you mention the best bands there?

Euronymous: "There is no scene in Norway, just lots of trendy children and totally normal idiots. the few bands we have here are starting to become very good, I'd really recommend the new 1p of DARK THRONE (A Blaze In The Northern Sky), it's so dark and so dark and gruesome, they have totally new style and I love it. CADAVER are CADAVER are love getting better and better even they don't play death metal, and you should watch for a band called THORNS, they will be better everything. than Their guitar player is a genious in making dark riffs, I've never heard anything like it before. It's been pretty quiet for a while, actually haven't seen any new stuff after the MERCILESS album, although I've heard that you have plans with many bands to do something. Is there perhaps going to be some releases in the future? near

Euronymous: "Not in the near future as we are too broke now. We have started up our own record shop, this might help out a bit, but it will still take time before we can spew out more releases. We killer albums have some



A new track is complete in around 2 weeks if it has to...but usually the usually the track is totally completed after 1-2 month after the first messy version. 95% of the whole BEHERIT material is written by me... the songwriting depends on the mental harmony and how the other things are at the time. Myself I'm quite productive at least in the light of the black candles and when the blood is dark and there's lot of it."

I think that's quite clear now, but what about the lyrics? Do write all of them, too? And please explain what is the idea behind the lyrics of Werewolf, Semen And Blood?

Holocausto: "Holocaust Vengeance is the master of the signs. Werewolf, Semen And Blood tells about how beautiful blood is, and and

about the altar of darkness when the wolflord is the master of the rites. The first lines are actually completely straight from my confused mind and the darkness of my soul. It was November'90 and downstairs of our rehearsal room. I was working on the lyrics at a really dark hour and you can't get any idea of them unless you're 100% into it. The rest of the lyrics are written by Dorian Grey (Black Metal Heathens, USA). was finished at the end of'90 when I imagined that through blood one could get into the soul of the wolf and into that world of which only few know. Now bless thyself..."

interesting! That's But why haven't you released that track (I know it should have included to the ep, but...) and the track Paradise Of The Demonic Host? In my opinion these are two of the best tracks of BEHERIT ...

Holocausto: "Werewolf, Semen And Blood is maybe going to be released in Turbo Music's Triumph Of Death compilation lp, and probably the song is going to be the cd-bonus track of Paradise the next album. (Of Thy Demonic Host) was only an idea to record something, we recorded it at the same time as the ep tracks, in September '90. Only a couple of our tracks, only a couple of only friends do have that track... why bother to have been one more tape to irritate people. It's cool you have the track, too. Yeps that's it, next question, please."

#### DARK FMOTIONS

I think usually you hadn't got the most clear sound on your recordings...do you have anything to comment?

"Money, Holocausto: money \$ and in the northern Finland we didn't find an

Well now I've learnt to recall the "old" times to my mind, I mean old times with BEHERIT, no trends, no commerciality, but real underground action... Now I've learnt also to feel and experience again experience again certain parts of brutality. Blood Upon The Altar by BLASPHEMY and SARCOFAGO's 1: summer Meta1 live House, MAYHEM, VARATHRON, SAMAEL!!! Trendy death metal will destroy you!!! So the ideas rise today from two years ago... can get real dark feelings and emotions when I'm alone and it's over 12pm, the cemetery of darkness, a gloomy forest or you're looking up from a mountain down there. Loneliness creates emotion to darkness, I love it, I love it... I'm on the shore of an enormous ocean, I can feel that call again and again (lä! Cthulhu fhtagn! -Niko)."

Does there exist any noticable shade of some certain style, in which BEHERIT could concentrate more in the future?

"BEHERIT Holocausto: shall continue as a fast and wicked band, and an underground group. Back to the old material, back to the tunnel, darkness.

How frequently do you practise?

Holocausto: "Today two times a week but in

past we sometimes practised even times a week.

Mention a couple of your favourite bands. Are you able to name the worst black/death metal band in opinion? vour Do listen to anything else but metal?

IN ASAI

Holocausto: "If I can mention only a couple of my faves, I name BATHORY. BLASPHEMY. ROTTING CHRIST. NECRO-SCHIZMA, RATOR. It's difficult to name the worst death metal band, because there are hundreds really pathetic! MORBIDITY is really a fucking crappy band from Finland, DAMNA-TORY, ATROCITY, MORGOTH and the shit like that. fuck there's so many shit bands around, you can get my list of them if you send me 5.50 stamp or \$2, hohoo. Of listen what there's 80% black metal, 15% thrash (old KREATOR, SLAYER) and 5% normal death metal or something fuck blahblah... in other words only good music. non-metal faves are OIL, GODFLESH, KIROUS, CROWLEY, LAVEY, BLACK MASSE + sound-tracks like Omen."

So what is opinion on Finnish underground (metal) scene, compared to the foreign countries? How high would you grade BEHERIT in Finnish underground scene (on the basis of how known/ popular a band is)? And what about the underground of the whole world?


Holocausto: opinion the Finnish scene is really trendy, not as much as in Sweden but however. When considered in general I can see that death metal scene our one of the best in the world. BEHERIT isn't trendy music, so it's clear that our music isn't popular here in Finland. Those XYSMA/CARCASS/OBITU-ARY/PARADISE LOST -bands get on better, but honestly can say that I don't give a shit about that. I think it's nice when people love us, but also that people hate us... it's really important to me. Maybe we are well known but not very

popular here in Finland. Abroad we are a very wellknown black metal band, and some even claim to like our music, probably it's bullshit (No way! -Niko) ...We don't want to be any kind of rockstars like some bands for an example in Finland. We do music for right people, not for the whole scene.

can see you're not completely satisfied with today's death metal scene. So there could be a lot of things that you'd like to change?

Holocausto: there is. Those false death metal bands (former false speed metal groups) should fuck off. record Big labels should stop this death metal activity, Metal Hammer, Rock Hard etc. shitmags should write only about things they know well, such as hard rock .. And then for an example if some death metal band got a good review from a rock magazine, under ground magazine, should be denied. underground Yeah, and in general those new fucking "death metal" bands get on my nerves. They're playing some ANTHRAX/MEGADETH-riffs with growling vocals and they think that's fucking fast and brutal death metal. I want back the old and real death metal scene.

So your opinion on these new death metal bands is that they are too trendy and ordinary...?

Holocausto: least 80% of today's bands are worth of nothing. I'm not able to even listen to new NAPALM DEATH, OBITUARY, DEATH kind of shit, and more and more bands try to play it. But it's their own problem, if that kind commercialism of feel interesting to them, free to float in that trendshit...feel free to buy all death metal cd's. I don't give a penny to them. Trendy music to trendies and other kind of wimps, fell free to be so fucking death maniacs with your stupid discs and fair jeans. MORGOTH, mosh, mosh death metal godzzz n:o 1? Well, we could get a lot of money with that trendy posing, but is it then true death metal underground music? Shit music? Shit...the same kind of shit like speed metal, hard rock, disco etc.etc."

Let's still talk while about this trendthing. Many, many people praise the Swedish underground scene, but is it really worth it? I'm not quite sure of it...

The scene

of Sweden is fulfilled with ENTOMBED trend. 10 good bands and over 100 megacrappy ones. My faves are example BATHORY, TIAMAT (TREBLINKA), AT THE GATES (GROTESQUE), CRYPT OF KERBEROS, ABRUPTUM, PAN THY MONIUM...but also AUTOPSY TORMENT, OBSCENE etc. The HAMMER OF DAMNATION

sure. Myself I can't say about the connection 'cause examinations on mv thing aren't finished yet. Occultism and horror literature, that's what it is, without any straight notes. I read also books by H.P. Lovecraft and I read them, too?"

Yes, certainly, to me Lovecraft is almost a deity himself! But let's talk a little about Satanism. As far as I know, these black metal Satanists worship Lucifer. the goatlord. But the main idea on Satanism is what thou wilt shall be the whole of the law", in other words Left Hand Path, isn't it? But how does it fit to satanism to bathe in breathe fire, use blood. masks and that kind of stuff that is quite usual amongst black metal bands?

"Good, Holocausto: really good question. we the "black metal Satanists" and "true Satanists' have a little war...maybe it has something to do with the war between Temple Of Set and Church Of Satan. Myself I think that these Temple Of Set people or at least the most of them are totally two-faced peole. First they are on the side of Church Of Satan...a goat and a pentagram are them main signs, wickedness and Satanic rituals. Then one beautiful day all changes, Satan is not Satan anymore, Set-Hen instead. Set-Hen and Horus are the real masters. Satan worship, Satanism, death metal. 



It is likely that every one into death metal has got the album Of Darkness... by the Swedish THERION. But what about the upcoming releases? Also the band's bass player has changed. Becuase of your curiosity it is necessary to open a little this curtain of ignorance...

So first of all, tell me what has happened to THERION since releasing your lp Of Darkness...

Chris: "We have changed a member. Erik our previous bass player moved to USA along with his family, se we got a new guy called Kristian, who earlier played guitar in the band GROTESQUE."

So the current line-up is Christofer (vocals / guitar), Peter (guitar), Oskar (drums) and this new guy Kristian (bass).

You made your first lp Deaf Records, but obviously you are not satisfied with em. Is your next lp coming out for some label, maybe Active different from the deal with Deaf? Anyway pose that Deaf Records had quite a good distribution since your records are for sale in quite commercial shops, at least here in Finland (Yes, it seems. But is it then really an underground thing? -Niko). Chris: "Deaf Records

Chris: "Deaf Records was ok, but the circumstances made things totally shit. It was mostly not their fault. We only signed for one lp, so they didn't have any reasons to put too much money in promotion for us. That's right, now we're signed to Active Records and this time we signed for 3 lp's."

Are you satisfied with Of Darkness...? What kind of response have you got? Has it been different from underground people compared to other ones?

to other ones? "We're quite satisfied with Of Dark-ness..., the songs are ok, and the production is acceptable. The only thing

who we wished we had done better is the arrangements."

Tell us something about your forthcoming records, will it be someway different apart Of Dark-ness...? Is there some radical changes or something like that?

Chris: "It will be called Beyond The Realms Of Death and will be released in January. After the release we'll do a european tour probably with ATHEIST. The new songs are more creative and original than the old ones. More complicated too. It's the same style, but we're progressed a lot."





Do you manage your gigs and all the arrangement by yourself or does your record company all that stuff? Are you an expensive band to get for the gig?...Do you in any circumstances go only by travelling money?

Chris: "So far we're managed all gigs by our selves. But when the tour comes, we can of course not do that. I would say we're rather cheap to get to a gig. When we're only doing one gig we only require money to pay the travelling costs, the food-money and money for hotel (or if the arranging guys is getting us somewhere to sleep is ok, too). But when there's a big tour with about 30 gigs in different countries you must take a bit more, otherwise you would loose a lot of money. When you do a tour you must take off almost 2 months from the job and by that you loose a hell of a lot of money."

What do you think of following bands; XYSMA, HANOI ROCKS, DISGRACE, A-HA, SENTENCED?

Chris: "XYSMA is one hell of a great band live, but on vinyl they are only quite good. I think it's the production who's destroying the songs on the

lp. They were godly when we played with them. I like one lp with HANOI ROCKS and that's Two Stephs From The More. A-HA is the worst crap I've ever heard! I've heard DISGRACE and SENTENCED, but unfortunatly I can't remember what I thought about them."

#### CONSCIOUSNESS

Are you aiming to live your life with the money that THERION brings to you, and do you think that by playing death metal you can get rich?

Get rich:

Chris: "Ha, ha! No, no one can get rich by playing death or thrash metal. Well my aim is to be able to live on the money! get, but! must say that if! work full-time on a normally-payed job, I can earn much more money than! ever can get from the band. So if!'m gonna live on the band!'ll be a really poor fellow. As it is right now, I work half-time, but the job is well-payed, so! can manage with this."

What do you think about this growing commercialism of death metal? And do you feel that this underground has lost some of it's meaning for THERION after you had got a good deal?

Chris: "It depends on what you mean. Of Course you want as good deal as possible. Yes, it is commercial to release records on bigger labels with good looking covers, but since the goal many bands have is

to spread the music, this the best way. The bigger label you got, the better distribution you get. And the better dis-tribution (and promotion) you get, the more records you sell, and the more records you sell, the more you spread your music.. The underground with it' fanzines, compilation tapes etc. has of course the biggest meaning to new bands with demos or rele-ased on extremely small labels, but as a death metal band, you can never get too big for the underground scene. What trying to say about THERION that of course we're alot involved in the underground. 75% of all death metal fans are more or less involved with the underground (and the rest is crap that follows the "true" ones! -Niko), so no manage band could ever without it."

Do you feel bored (sometimes) answering all these interviews and all kinds of letters?

Chris: "Well a lot of zines have the same questions, so sometimes it can be very boring to answer the same question a million times. But otherwise I like answering letters. It's just that I get so extremely much letters, so it causes delays on my answers. At this moment, I'm the only one who writes THERION letters."

Down There... is the title of this demo'91, by the lord DIABOLUS. There's 3 tracks of pure occult male-volence and a spoken intro, and the listener must be noticed by the discharge of evilness which blows out of your loudspeakers...

The second track Nocturnal Evil seems to be my favourite, there's included a couple of slow, heavy parts in the middle of this SARCOFAGO, BLASPHEMY-influenced black metal chaotic blur.





But no, there are a few differences...but certainly there is a Swedish touch! 3 tracks plus XYS-MA-cover Why Am I !? I also had a bonus surprise on my tape; a track called The Three Seasons (today titled With Eyes Shut) which is recorded during rehearsals in May'91. It's faster and there also vocals by Mika. 



was April in 1987 Anno Satanas when SAMAEL was procreated by Vorphalack (guitar / vo-From there until cals). now, they have released a rehearsal demo Into The Infernal Storm Of Evil '87, the 7"ep '88 Medieval Prophecy, which sold very well and spread the name in the underground, a promo demo with two songs in 1990, and now in 1991 their finally debut full-length album entitled Worship Him, which was by the way recorded already in March 1990. And at the latest this should raise SAMAEL to one of the most interesting and original underground bands today.

Well, the band's lineup nowadays is Vorphalack (guitar/vocals), Xytraguptor (drums) and Masmiseim (bass).

Vorphalack's comment on their names is: "Our pseudonym haven't any meaning (except for us) it's our Ritual names."

Okay. How are you, Vorphalack, today there at the darkest of darkness?

Vorphalack: "I feel tired and cold."

Since you seem to have there the right atmosphere for talking about the album Worship Him, why wouldn't we?

Vorphalack: "I don't know how many copies of it we've sold 'till now but Osmose Productions tell us it has sold very well. Worship Him was recorded in March '90 so it is a little bit old recording. I think the sound is OK. It was our first experience in Studio, next one will be better."

Could you ever compare it musically to your debut vinyl release Medieval Prophecy?

Vorphalack: "Musically of course, the songs of Medieval Prophecy appear on Worship Him. Just the sound is different (I think I have noticed that the versions differ a bit from each other; for an example The Dark didn't have those exciting whispers and that strange piping... - Niko the Santa Claus). Worship Him it's a kind of compilation of all the old

stuff."

What about the feedback you've got about the album?

Vorphalack: "In general the reaction is good, people who dislike Black Metal can't like our album."

What differences do you see when comparing SAMAEL to other (Death Metal etc.) bands? By the way, I think that your voice is very original (I think so, too!!! -Niko the idiot).

Vorphalack: "Thanx for compliment on my voice. The major difference between SAMAEL and other Death Metal bands is simple, we don't play Death Metal. We try at first to create an ambiance, technic and melody aren't important for me. In fact I try to find the right atmosphere for my lyrics."

#### THE RITES OF CTHULHU

Now it's the right time to chat a bit about your songwriting process and the things like that. What is the procreation of a SAMAEL track like? Do you only

make a couple of riffs and then make the song or do you make the whole song only within your brains like Mozart?

Vorphalack: "We make a lot of improvisation when we play together and we take the best part. Sometimes it's different. I don't like Mozart."

Now, where do you rehearse and how many times a week? Is it expensive or don't you pay anything of it?

Vorphalack: "We practise three times a week together. We have a place to rehearse at 10km from our homes. We don't need to pay anything for it."

Who is the main song writer in the band? Your lyrics are about occultism, aren't they?

Vorphalack: "I write all the lyrics and 80% of the music. Lyrics deal with occultism, sorcery, death and all what is Evil!"

Then you should be the right person to tell why did you include a riff from some old (Russian?) song in your song Knowledge Of The Ancient Kingdom?

Vorphalack: "The riff come from a Russian songs, We've take it 'cause we liked it. It's not for any particulare reason."

Is there nice to live in Switzerland? Is there the army like here in Finland? Are you going to the army?

Vorphalack: "Switzer-land is a nice country, maybe too nice. We want to leave this place as soon as we can, because nothing interesting happens here. Swiss army sucks like every other army."

What about the gig

What about the gig situation there in Switzerland? Are you perhaps coming here in Finland?

Vorphalack: "Here in Switzerland we've lot of gigs but this is a small country so bands can't make



a tour here, they only play one gig, no more, and it's enough. I hope to play in Finland in the future but we haven't planned anything till now."





Let's then change the country, Do you know any Finnish bands? Give me a Finnish bands: ... list please (Hahaha)... "Yeah!



Also Jari should raise (or create, I should say) some kind of 'treshold of publication', this zine contains many, many nauseating questions in those interviews, I mean that at least I demand some kind of information about the band itself, not about what the interviewed person ate for breakfast! Well, that was just an example...

The most positive point in this zine is the price; in Finland you can get this for only 5mk, but to other countries \$2US should be enough...

Although being A5-size and written in Finnish, this really differs from most of the Finnish A5 zines.

Of course there are things that could have been done better, such as unclear pictures, sometimes slightly messy layout and copying rate. But the stories are informative, and there are much worse stuff that costs you lOFim. So buy this if you like to read stuff about ANTIDOTE, DISHARMONIC ORC., MCCROPHOBIC, SCEPTICAL SCHIZO, XYSMA, MAPLE CROSS etc. To foreign coutries \$3/\$4 should do, but remember that it's written in Finnish!





A band with the name CARTI-LAGE sounds like they were playing some kind of grind /deathcore with slight hcinfluences. In other words the kind of stuff I'm not interested at all.

But this one year old (new!) Finnish band (containing Mikki Salo:vocals, Mikko Hannuksela : guitar, Karri Suoraniemi : guitar, Harri Huhtala:bass and Kai Hahto:drums) plays death metal; quite ordinary kind of, but in my opinion a bit over average. The proof of that is their debut demo'91, entitled In Godly Flesh.

First there's an instrumental intro (namely Carnival Of Souls) which is fairly boring in my opinion. But the follower, The Altar, excretes some quite good riffing, that reminds me of the Norwegian gods DARK THRONE in their debut album. Other bands that come to my mind are BOLT THROWER (mainly because of the vocals, I guess) and the Finnish DEMIGOD (read an interview elsewhere...).

The next track, To Your Scattered Bodies Go, doesn't move me to any direction, it seems to be a bit weaker than The Altar.

Then we'll turn the B-side on, and there's something more interesting to be found! Namely, the track Infernal Paradise... The Journey is suddenly far from the stuff of the side A. The best riffing is to be found here, and also the song structure is more interesting than in the earlier tracks which used to have quite a usual structure.

It's a pity the lyrics



#### SUFFOCATED BEGINNING...

The "financial" side: How many copies have you sold your demos, and what has the response been like?

Vesa: "When Death
Joins Us... got a surprising response from the
underground. In the beginning we were totally
confused when the letters
started to flow from every
corner of the earth.
Because of many (10000)
flyers and advertising it

sold over 500 copies. Free copies to zines, labels etc. were given away around 100 copies. We haven't been too busy promoting Rotting Ways To Misery, because the lp is coming out soon. Despite the small advertising it has sold until now (31.10.91) about 400 copies which is quite good I guess. The response on it has been positive..."

Can you say who are the most active ones in composing the music in the band? And what about your lyrics?

Vesa: "Miika (guitar/vocals) and Sami (guitar) make the music. The lyrics are being written by Tane (bass) and Sami. Lyrics are about everything weird such as the dark and cold truth of life and death..."

In the demo there was still the guy Lari handling the bass; so you have changed him to this new guy you mentioned, Tane...?

Vesa: "Yeah, Lari got

Vesa: "Yeah, Lari got kicked out and replaced by Tane. I think we have now found the final line-up and won't change it again. So the present line-up looks like this: Miika - guitar/vocals (17), Vesa - drums (18), Tane - bass (17) and Sami - guitar (17)."

What kinds of bands and things inspire you musically? What is the song writing process of SENTENCED like?

Vesa: "Bands that inspire us are DARK THRONE, PARADISE LOST, BOLT THROWER, ENTOMBED. Things that inspire us are the pain and

anguish of life and "eternal misery". The song writing process looks pretty simple. Miika and Sami make some riffs at their homes, and play them to us in our rehearsals. We forsake bad riffs, and from good riffs we make a song. We pay quite much attention to arrange the riffs to fit them well together, we try to make as

coherent tracks as possible."

Then describe your music with five words! Vesa: "Our music is: Dark, cold, gloomy, deadly deathmetal."

#### THE TRUTH

Let's then talk about your deal with the French Thrash Records...

"It's a Vesa: one album deal. Our lp should be released in December, I don't know the correct date yet. Lp will include eight tracks (one bonus track on CD), the titles are: When The Moment Of Death Arrives (I've got this track as a bonus' And it's really good! -Niko), Rot To Dead, Disengagement, Rotting Ways To Misery, The Truth, Suffocated Beginning Of Life, Beyond The Distant Valleys, Under The Suffer, Descending Curtain Of Death. We recorded the master tape 10-15 October, in Tico-Tico studio, Kemi."

Do you think you should have got the deal maybe earlier, or was this just the right time for it?

Vesa: "I think it was the right time for us. In my opinion many Finnish death metal bands have got the deal too late, about a year ago a couple of bands should have got on vinyl... but better late than never. During these days many finnish bands are about to release their debut lp's, and it's a great thing..."

You also played in the Finnish deathrash band

ANTHONY (R.I.P.)...
Vesa: "Yes. ANTHONY
splitted up almost at the same time | joined
SENTENCED. | left ANTHONY
because | got fed up with playing typical death/
thrash, | just want to play pure death metal."

#### ... WAYS TO MISERY

Tell something about your rehearsals. What is the place like and do you practise often?

Vesa: "We practise in our shed-like building which is like built to be a rehearsal place, about 3-5 times a week, it depends on inspiration. Our rehearsals last usually about 2-3 hours."

the gigs of yours...? Vesa: "Our gig situation is by now pretty good, around 2-3 gigs a month. About 25 gigs have been done, we haven't kept on Some counting very well. have asked us to come playing abroad, it's possible that we'll visit Sweden in early '92. We have also asked Pat (Thrash Rec.) to arrange a couple gigs in France. But everything is uncertain yet, so I say nothing more about it."

DESCENDING CURTAIN...

How long do you think SENTENCED will be around? Do you think you could keep on playind this kind of music when your 30 of age or over?

"Nobody knows Vesa: the correct answer to this question. I guess SENTEN-CED will still be around for many years, show. I don't think we'll play this kind of music in show. our thirties, then I want to play extremely brutal deathcore, heh heh.

Are you developing your music to some certain style, or what? And how much are there possibilities to develop your style?

Vesa: "Hmm... there could be many directions to change our music to, but we don't try to create anything too constrained or artificial. I think our music will be in the future quite same like today, but probably the tracks will contain colder and darker atmosphere, and more sad melodies...



From Belgium comes this band of which name must be taken from DEICIDE's track title. The band was formed 1987 under the name MORBID DEATH.

The first release was the demo called **Demoniac**. By the time the music was mostly thrashy type like KREATOR, SEPULTURA etc. In October'90 was the time to release their second demo Diabolic Forces, which was much more death metal.

In October '91 the band (Dan - bass&vocals, Patrick and Eddy - guitars and Fab - drums) changed its name to BLASPHEREION, and got a deal with Osmose Productions. Kindly enough Osmose Prod. sent me a three track advance tape of this 1p, which is by the way titled Rest In Peace (the 1p |

mean!).

This tape has 3 songs as I already said; they are titled Church Of Lies, Hells Of Pain and Demon's The music is fast death metal, quite close to DEICIDE. But I prefer BLA-SPHEREION, they don't sound so extremely boring as DEI-CIDE, of whose music I have never been into. Other possible influences might be bands like INCANTATION, GOREFEST and maybe IMMOLA-TION.






